
The following scholarships are being offered:

1. Fulbright **US-ASEAN VISITING SCHOLARS PROGRAM** for university faculty, foreign ministry and government officials, and professionals in think tanks and other NGOs. The minimum period for an award is three months, and the maximum period is four months. Interested applicants are encouraged to reach out to the respective Embassy or Fulbright Commission for timeline specifics;
2. **US FULBRIGHT ASEAN SPECIALIST PROGRAM** for university faculty, foreign ministry and government officials, and professionals in think tanks and other NGOs. Award periods are flexible and should be congruent with the needs of the projects. The minimum period for an award is two weeks and the maximum period is six weeks. Interested applicants are encouraged to reach out to the respective Embassy or Fulbright Commission for timeline specifics;
