- Identify issues and concerns re implementation of *DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2008*
- Formulate doable recommendations to resolve identified issues and concerns
- Discuss action points to access support as provided for by *DepEd Order No. 18, s. 2008*

Travel expenses and other expenditures relative to the activity for the participant-Private Madaris shall be charged against PRIME Fund.
