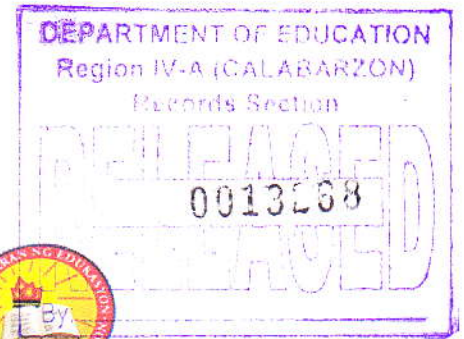

The Manila Ocean Park Contest for Teachers

Definition of the Contest:

The Manila Ocean Park Christmas Teachers Got Talent is a talent show contest that aims to revive the spirit of Christmas amongst the teaching and non-teaching staff of the schools in NCR, Regions I, III and IV-A. Theme of the contest is "Christmas by the Bay"

A. WHO CAN JOIN

A teacher or group of teachers in the above mentioned regions. They must be a bonafide member of the teaching and non-teaching staff of the school.

B. HOW TO JOIN/ENTRY FORMS

1. Contestant/Schools concerned must express their desire to join by informing/submitting the name of the staff, name of school and contact numbers/emails to DepEd Regional PESS office and MaryLindbert Int'l.
2. A sample recording of the talent to perform must be submitted for the pre-qualifications/judging by the Department of Education PESS and MaryLindbert Int'l.

4. The best five entries from each region will compete in the final competitions.
5. Chosen finalists will be informed by DepEd and Marylindbert Int'l on or before December 5, 2014.
6. Contest finals will be held on December 12, 2014 in Manila Ocean Park.
7. Registration starts at 8am-9am

C. Teachers Got Talent Contest

1. Pre-qualification elimination
 - a. All interested schools must submit the contest requirements on the date specified above.
 - b. Submitted sample recording in CD format will be basis for elimination.
 - c. Top five (5) entries per region will be chosen for the finals
2. Contest Finals
 - a. All finalists must render their talent on stage for a maximum of 10 minutes.
 - b. Finalists must submit another recording in CD format of their talent to perform
 - c. All employees of The Manila Ocean Park, its PR, advertising agencies, suppliers and relatives up to the second degree consanguinity and affinity are disqualified from joining the contest.

D. SELECTION/JUDGING

- The Final Judging will be on December 12, 2014 at The Manila Ocean Park.
- The panel of Judges will choose the winning entries.
- The decision of the Judges is Final.
