1. To ensure the effective and efficient implementation of the Special Curricular Program in Science, Technology and Engineering (STE) and the Regional Science High School (RSHS) Program within the framework of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, the Department of Education, through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), will conduct the following activities:

2. The Annual Assessment intends to evaluate the readiness of the schools to implement the *Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) Program*, one of the Academic Tracks for senior high school students. The participants in the said assessment activity are the school coordinators of the STE-implementing high schools. Each participant is advised to bring the accomplished *School Year (SY) 2013-2014 STE Survey Form* and a laptop.

3. The Annual Conference aims to provide a forum to update the participants on program policies and guidelines and to prepare them for the implementation of the Enriched STEM Program. The participants in the conference are the school heads (SHs) of the 200 STE-implementing high schools identified in DepEd Order No. 15, s. 2014, SHs of the Regional Science High Schools (RSHSs), and Regional Science Education Supervisors. The participants are advised to bring their *SY 2013-2014 STE Implementation Plan Report*, including the financial statement on the utilization of the program support fund/subsidy, and a laptop.

4. Travel expenses and other incidental expenses of the SHs and school coordinators shall be charged to the program support fund/subsidy, while the costs of training including board and lodging, honoraria, supplies and materials, travel expenses of BSE staff and resource persons, and other incidental expenses shall be charged to the BSE Policy Formulation Fund, as provided for in the 2014 General Appropriations Act (GAA). Travel expenses of the Regional Science Education Supervisors, however, shall be charged to local funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.


