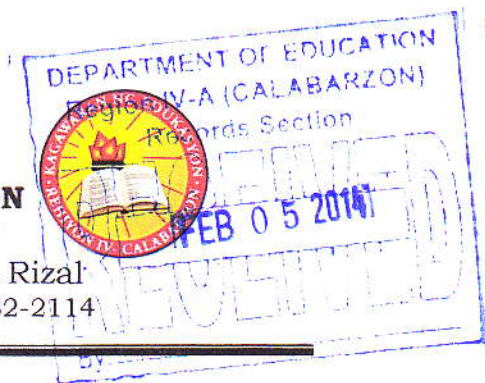

The Department of Education Region IV A-CALABARZON through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) congratulates the winners of the Regional Schools Press Conference (RSPC) for SY 2013-2014 held on January 26-29, 2014 in the Schools Division of Dasmaringas City. The official results per category are enclosed herewith.

In preparation for 2014 National Schools Press Conference (NSPC), the following Campus Journalist (CJ) winners together with their respective School Paper Adviser (SPA) and Education Program Supervisors-In-Charge of Journalism shall undergo a one-week cliniquing on February 17-21 at Tagaytay National High School:

- a. Ranks 1-3 in 8 categories (Individual Contests with 2 mediums) *Elementary & Secondary Levels;*
- b. Rank 1 in Radio Broadcasting and Scriptwriting Contests (7 CJs in English & 7 CJs in Filipino) *Elementary & Secondary Levels; and*
- c. Rank 1 in Collaborative Publishing Contests (7 CJs in English & 7 CJs in Filipino) *Elementary & Secondary Levels.*

There shall be NO REGISTRATION FEE. Participants shall take care of their own transportation, food, accommodation and other related expenses which may be charged to MOOE, provincial local funds or the city's Special Education Fund, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

Honoraria, board and lodging and transportation of trainers/speakers, supplies and other related expenses shall be charged against the Regional Funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

All Education Program Supervisors-In-Charge of Journalism with their respective SPAs must be responsible not only for the food, accommodation and transportation of their Campus Journalist winners but also for their safety and security all throughout the one-week cliniquing. Thus, the parents' permit and medical certificates duly signed by the Schools Division Superintendent must be submitted to the registration committee of the host school. A copy of which must also be given to the Regional Technical Working Group upon arrival.

Attendance of all concerned during this one-week cliniquing is highly enjoined but their participation to this activity shall be subject to the no-disruption-of-classes' policy as stipulated in DepED Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.

In addition, this Office would also like to remind the top 10 winners on each section/category for the group contest of the submission of their school paper entries to 2014 NSPC following the technical specifications for both elementary and secondary levels stated in DepED Memorandum No. 9, s. 2014 on Friday, February 7, 2014 not later than 5:00 PM at the CLMD c/o Ms. Jennifer E. Lopez.

Immediate dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
