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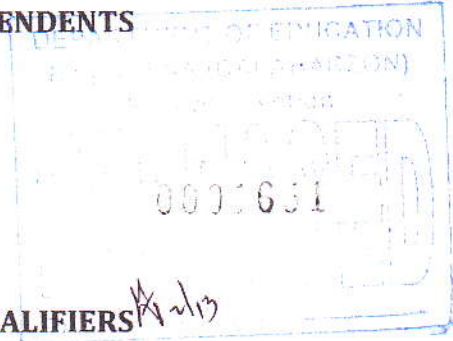

Lopez. Strict monitoring and supervision of all concerned with regard to the implementation of this Cliniquing Program is highly solicited.

For the Regional Cliniquing on February 17-21, 2014, participants are requested to be at Tagaytay City National High School by 5:00 PM of February 16, 2014 (Sunday) for the opening program and orientation. Presidents of the Regional Association of School Paper Advisers are also encouraged to attend.

Subsequently, the regional consultative meeting of Education Program Supervisors in English/Filipino/Journalism will follow at 7:00 P.M. (Attendance of the RACAS is a must).

The participants must bring laptops (with broadband internet connection if possible), camera, printer, and extension wires for their collaborative publishing, photojournalism, and feature writing workshops. In addition, they are also advised to bring the following: bedding, water heater, jackets / sweat shirts, umbrella and off lotion.

The host school/division is requested to organize the working committees on program, registration, documentation, venue and accommodation, ICT, medical and security. In addition, the school canteen is also requested to be open for the participants all throughout the week.
