

To heighten the awareness of educational administrators, leaders and managers in Calabarzon on the need to realize the DepEd Vision and Mission through good governance, DepEd-Calabarzon has partnered with the Philippine Association of Schools Division Superintendents (PASS Calabarzon Chapter) and the Regional Association of Communications Arts Supervisors (RACAS) in organizing the **Forum on Transparent, Ethical and Accountable Governance** on February 27, 2014, 9:00-4:30 pm at the Ynares Sports Complex, Rizal Capitol Compound, Circumferential Road, Brgy. San Roque, Antipolo City.

At the end of the forum, which focuses on the theme: **“Pamamahalang Tapat Para Sa Edukasyong Sapat”**, the participants are expected to:

- Manifest commitment to adopt leadership and management practices that strengthen Transparent, Ethical and Accountable Governance in DepEd Calabarzon;
- Explore effective ways of nurturing personal & professional integrity;

- Effectively manage personal and government resources towards enriched basic education services; and
- Appreciate the value of TEA Governance in the pursuit of high quality, relevant and complete basic education.

Participants to the said forum are all the heads and officers-in-charge (OICs) of public elementary and secondary schools, public schools district and division/regional education program supervisors, assistant schools division superintendents (ASDS), schools division superintendents (SDS), Regional Unit Heads, Assistant Regional Director (ARD) and the Regional Director.

Participants shall come with packed meals (morning/afternoon snacks and lunch) wearing semi-formal attire at least 30 minutes before the start of the program.

A registration fee of **One Hundred Pesos (P100.00)** shall be collected from each participant through the division offices to defray operational costs (sound system, hall rental, tokens for resource persons, supplies and materials and other related expenses), chargeable against local funds subject to the usual accounting procedures and auditing rules.
