To ensure a competitive Team CALABARZON in the 2014 Palarong Pambansa on May 4-10, 2014 in Laguna, Live-in Sports Training for the Region IV-CALABARZON Delegates to the 2014 Palarong Pambansa shall be conducted on March 29 to April 30, 2014 at San Luis RECS Village, Sta. Cruz, Laguna.

All candidate athletes, coaches, chaperons and trainers are required to be at the training venue and attend the orientation on March 29, 2014. They are also advised to bring their own mattresses and beddings. Screening and interview of athletes, coaches and chaperons shall be done on March 30, 2014 at the training venue.

General Guidelines on the Selection of Athletes, Coaches and Chaperons shall be strictly implemented. It is emphasized that athletes, coaches, chaperons and trainers who fail to promptly report at the training venue and miss two days of this training program shall be replaced.

All events except gymnastics will have their training at San Luis RECS Village, Sta. Cruz, Laguna to maximize the use of the sports facilities and get accustomed to the playing venues. Because of the unavailability of gymnastics equipment in regional training venue, the team will be trained using the training facilities of the Gymnastics Association of the Philippines (GAP) in Manila.

The live-in training will have a break from April 17 to 20, 2014 in the observance of the Holy Week. All coaches, trainers and athletes will leave the training venue in the morning of April 16 and must be back to the venue in the afternoon of April 20.

Division PESS Supervisors/Sports Coordinators are enjoined to report at the training venue to serve as monitoring officials as per schedule and attend the orientation on March 29, 2014, 1:00 p.m at San Luis RECS Village, Sta. Cruz, Laguna. Likewise, Regional Screening and Accreditation Committee are required to report to the training venue from March 29 to April 2, 2014 for the re-evaluation of documents and actual interview of athletes, coaches and chaperons.

Attached is the list of delegation and monitoring officials for the live-in training. Teaching personnel shall be given ten (10) days service credits while non-teaching personnel shall be given compensatory leave credits based on the actual services rendered during weekends and holidays.

Travel expenses of the participants in going to the training venue shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
