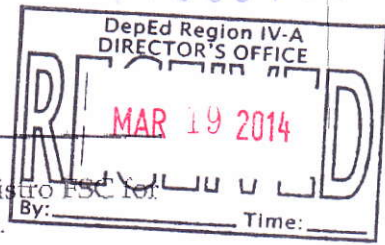

Attached for your reference is the message of Secretary Br. Armin A. Luistro FSC for the SY 2014 Graduation. Both English and Tagalog versions are included.

The rites should focus on the theme "Hindi Natitinag ang Pusong Pilipino". As stated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2014, " this theme highlights the resilience of the Filipino spirit amidst the recent calamities faced during the school year. It also celebrates the ability of the Filipinos to triumph over these challenges".

We would like to reiterate the pronouncement of the Secretary to maintain the solemnity of the occasion by keeping the rites simple but meaningful. He stressed further that, graduation rites should not be used as a political forum and "extravagant attires and venues are not necessary to make an impression, the important thing is we send the message of nationalism, excellence and resilience to every graduate".

Here are other reminders from DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2014:

Item no. 3.b. Non-academic projects such as attendance to field trips, film showing, JS Promenade, and other school events, but not limited to these events should not be imposed as requirements for graduation;

For Public Schools only:

Item no. 3.c. Expenses relative to the activity should be charged to the school Maintenance and Other Operating Expenses (MOOE) under the 2014 Budget;

Item no. 3.d. No DepEd personnel is allowed to collect any graduation fees or any kind of contribution;

Muli, binabati ko ang mga magsisipagtapos. Hangad ko ang inyong tagumpay.

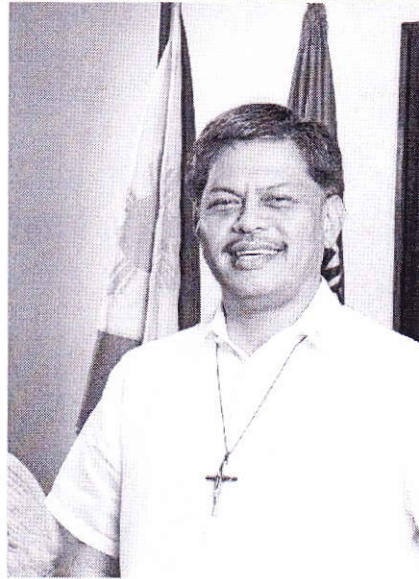
