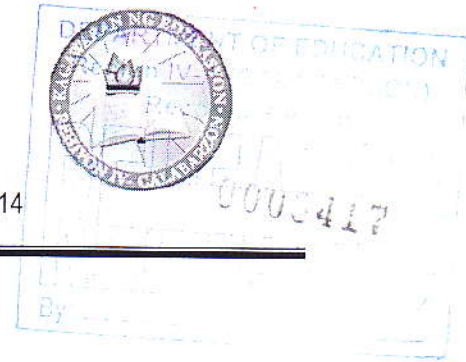

Greetings from DSWD Field Office IV-A! We are informing you that Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program (Pantawid Pamilya) will soon cater beneficiaries ages 15-18 through the extended age coverage (EAC). The list of additional children that will be monitored came from the family roster of Pantawid Pamilya beneficiaries and are already identified by the National Household Targeting Office (NHTO). Aside from EAC, there will be a total of 38,438 additional households included on the newest batch of Set 7 in the region. The expansion will entail community assemblies, validation, and orientation that will prepare both the beneficiaries and the LGU on the provisions and conditionalities of the program.


Due to the continuous expansion of the program, we will update our data on public education facilities / institutions by conducting the Annual Supply Side Assessment from April to September 2014. The assessment aims to identify the likely impact of Pantawid on the education system and determine the readiness of the LGUs for the increase in demand for education services. With this, we are asking the assistance of your good office in the distribution and retrieval of the assessment forms for education. This collaboration will help ensure the credibility of the QSSA data since it will pass through the review of the facility heads, supervisors and division chiefs. The C/MLs and SSA Focal may orient the respondents during the City/ Municipal Advisory Committee Meetings and district/division meetings/ seminars, respectively.

Also, we will need an updated list of elementary and secondary schools following the format attached on this letter. The format includes the identification of schools providing ALS and ADM and the number of enrollees on these schools.
