





1. With the end in view at strengthening the professional, moral and personal as well as the social development of the education supervisors of the Region, DepEd CALABARZON in partnership with the Philippine Association of Schools Superintendents CALABARZON Chapter is conducting a Calabarzon Conference of Learning Leaders with theme ***“Promoting TEA Governance in Instructional Supervision: A Commitment to the Learners of Today and Beyond”*** on May 27-28, 2014 at DAP, Tagaytay City. This will be the first in a series of quarterly meetings initiated by this Region of CY 2014 starting this second quarter.
2. This conference aims to:
 - Promote transparent, ethical and accountable delivery of instructional services and governance in basic education.
 - Strengthen supervisors' leadership towards continuous improvement.
 - Enhance participant's knowledge, skills and attitude on the concept and processes of Instructional Supervision under the K-12 program and the emerging roles of Supervisors in the rationalized structure of DepEd.

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- Come up with Strategic and Supervisory Plan in response to the teacher, learners and community needs using operational and technical inputs on Instructional Supervision.
3. The participants in this conference are education program supervisors (EPSs), public schools district supervisors (PSDSs), schools division superintendents (SDSs), assistant schools division superintendents (ASDSs), regional supervisors, OIC supervisors and selected RO officials/personnel.
