

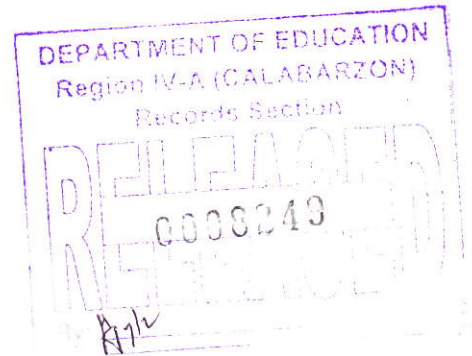

SUBJECT : AMENDMENT TO MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO. 2013-18
DATED MARCH 4, 2013 ENTITLED "IMPLEMENTATION OF
THE BARANGAY TARGETING SYSTEM FOR OUT-OF-SCHOOL
YOUTH (OSY) UNDER "ABOT-ALAM"

In view of the postponement of the Sangguniang Kabataan Election pursuant to RA No. 10632 entitled "An Act to Postpone the Sangguniang Kabataan Elections on October 28, 2013, Amending for the Purpose Republic Act No. 9340 and for Other Purposes", some provisions of DILG MC No. 2013-18 dated March 4, 2013 are hereby amended as follows:

In support of the program, all Provincial Governors, City/Municipal Mayors, Punong Barangays, Liga Chapter Presidents shall ensure that all Out of School Youths (ages 15-30 years old) in their respective jurisdictions are registered in the OSY inventory list.

In the preparation of the list, the following shall be undertaken:

At the Barangay level:

1. Under the supervision of the Punong Barangay, the Barangay Secretary shall prepare the list of all OSYs ages 15-30 years old in his/her respective barangay using the NYC Form No. 1 and submit the same to the Component City/Municipal Liga Chapter President;
2. For the barangays with computer and internet access, the Barangay Secretary may prepare and directly submit the list to the NYC using the Abot-Alam website copy furnished the Component City/Municipal Liga Chapter President using NYC Form No. 1.

At the City/ Municipal Level

1. The City/Municipal Liga Chapter Presidents shall ensure that all OSYs in his/her city/municipality are registered in the OSY list.
2. The City/Municipal Liga Chapter Presidents shall consolidate the list of OSYs of all barangays in his/her city or municipality using NYC Form No. 2 and e-mail it to: alor.alam@nlc.gov.ph, copy furnished the Provincial, Regional and the National Liga Chapter Presidents.

At the HUC/ICC Level

3. In case for Highly Urbanized and Independent Component City, the HUC/ICC Liga Chapter Presidents shall consolidate the list of OSYs of all barangays in his/her city or municipality using NYC Form No. 2 and e-mail it to: alor.alam@nlc.gov.ph, copy furnished the National Liga Chapter Presidents.
4. The HUC/ICC/CC Liga Chapter Presidents and the Municipal Liga Chapter Presidents shall ensure that funds for the purpose are provided by concerned LGU.

At the Provincial Level

1. The Provincial Liga Chapter Presidents shall ensure that all the city/municipalities in his/her province have registered, consolidated and submitted the list of all OSYs to NYC, copy furnished the Regional and National Liga Chapter Presidents.
2. The Provincial Liga Chapter Presidents shall ensure that funds for the purpose are provided by concerned LGU.

Likewise, all Provincial Governors, City/Municipal Mayors, and Punong Barangays, Liga Chapter Presidents, at all levels shall provide for the necessary funds to ensure the successful implementation of the activity, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations and other laws.

All DILG Regional Directors and Field Officers are hereby directed to cause the widest dissemination of this Memorandum Circular.

RESOLUTION NO. 2014 – 004

ENDORSEMENT OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION'S ABOT ALAM PROGRAM FOR THE OUT-OF-SCHOOL YOUTH

Whereas, Abot Alam is a convergence program under the Human Development and Poverty Reduction Cluster (HDPRC) that envisions a Zero OSY Philippines. Through the collective effort of national government agencies, local government units, civil society organizations, the private sector, and community-based groups, ABOT-ALAM aims to map out all the country's out of school youth aged 15-30 and match them with appropriate government or civil society programs that will give them opportunities for education, employment, and entrepreneurship;

Whereas, the Union of Local Authorities of the Philippines (ULAP) and its member leagues – the League of Provinces of the Philippines, League of Cities of the Philippines, League of Municipalities of the Philippines, Liga ng mga Baranagay, Philippine Councilors League, and National Movement of Young Legislators – signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Department of Education and other partners to:

- (a) Mobilize local governments both in gathering data on the out-of-school youth in their respective communities and in making local resources available for the success of Abot-Alam, by issuing memoranda, notices, and other relevant issuances, and,
- (b) Encourage their members to support and participate by pushing for the implementation of the program and allocating resources for activities within their respective jurisdictions;

Whereas, on motion made and duly seconded among the ULAP NEB, BE IT RESOLVED, AS IT HEREBY RESOLVED:

That the ULAP NEB encourages all member leagues and local governments to support the Abot Alam program, in line with the commitments made by ULAP and its member leagues with the Department of Education.
