The Philippine Home Economics Association (PHEA) will hold its *66th Annual National Conference and Training* with the theme *The Role of Home Economics in the Pursuit of Hope and Happiness for Filipino Learners and Education Communities* from October 24 to 26, 2014 at the Pinnacle Hotel and Suites, Sta. Ana Avenue, Davao City Center, Davao City.

The Conference and Training aim to:

1. ensure the provision of comprehensive and in-depth information on the new Technology and Livelihood Education (TLE) and *Edukasyong Pantahanan at Pangkabuhayan* (EPP) Curriculum under the Expanded Basic Education Program (EBEP);
2. provide updates on the Senior High School (SHS) Curriculum and Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (TVL) Track;
3. conduct hands-on training on mini courses aligned with Technical Education Skills Development Authority (TESDA) accreditation for National Certificate (NC) II or NC III; and
