Dear Dr. San Antonio:

We would like to request for the issuance of a DepEd Memorandum from your Office for the information of those concerned on the 2014 Battle of ICT Wizards as per DepEd Advisories No. 282 and 175, s. 2014 (*attached*). Due to time constraints in disseminating information and to give students ample time to prepare for this event, we would also like to request that the Regional Finals of the Southern Luzon A Cluster be **moved from Friday, September 19 to Friday, October 17, 2014** with **San Pablo Colleges (Laguna)** as venue host. The October 3 schedule for the Southern Luzon B Cluster will remain as is, with **St. Jude Parish School (Trece Martires City)** as venue host.

In 2006, 2010 and 2012, we held our first three ICT battles for elementary and high school students. The competitions successfully had a total of over 3,000 participants from 300 public and private schools all over the country. The regional contests were held in five key cities while the Grand Finals were held in Manila.

The 2014 theme of the CAL Battle of the ICT Wizards is "Going Global with ICT". This theme coincides with the worldwide efforts of government, corporations, institutions and organizations to maximize the use of Information and Communications Technology in the country by harnessing our premiere human resource – the Pinoy Techie. The contest participants will be utilizing different computer applications and programs to create innovative designs in the fields of Digital Arts, Web Design, and Programming.

The contest is open to all elementary and high school students from both public and private schools. They will be competing in the following categories: Elementary–Quiz Bee and MS Powerpoint; High School–Quiz Bee, Poster Design Using Adobe Photoshop, Web Design Using xHTML/Dreamweaver, Applications Programming Using Visual Basic, AVP Using Adobe Flash, Digital Photography, and on-the-spot PC Assembly/Troubleshooting. The regional competitions will commence on October 2014, while the Grand Finals will take place in Manila on January 2015.
