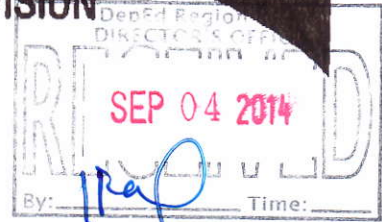

1. The Department of Education (DepEd) supports the National Council for Children's Television (NCCT) in its vision to empower the Filipino children to speak out and stand up for their rights through the **Sixth CinePambata Video Festival's One-Minute Video Competition**.

2. The Competition aims to raise awareness on issues concerning children and promote positive Filipino values among the youth through showcasing videos for, by, and about children themselves. Since 2009, NCCT has annually held the Festival in celebration of the children's month every October.

3. The Competition is open to all Filipinos aged 17 and below. The production team must be composed of a maximum of ten members coming from the same school, *barangay*, or organization. The entries must be 60-second public service announcements about the rights and experiences of children.

4. Entries may be submitted either in person or through mail to the address indicated in Enclosure No. 1 and must be received by the organizers on or before **September 5, 2014**.

5. Shortlisted videos will be screened during the Festival to be held in four major cities in the Philippines in October. Winners will receive plaques, certificates, and monetary prizes.
