The Teachers Dignity Coalition (TDC) in coordination with the Civil Society Network for Education Reforms (E-Net Philippines) and the Asia-South Pacific Association for Basic and Adult Education (ASPBAE) will hold a **Luzon-Wide Consultation-Workshop on Education For All (EFA)** on **November 28-30 at the OMI Retreat House, Mangga Street, Mapayapa Village I Capitol Site, Quezon City.**

With the theme: **"Education for All: a Commitment of All the Teachers"** the activity aims to:

1. equip the teacher-leaders with knowledge on the Education For All commitment of the Philippines;
2. provide the teachers with information on pertinent issues of education sector; and
3. develop modules for the advocacy on education reforms.

Aside from the said theme, other topics such as GASTPE and other PPP programs in education, education financing and budget process and teachers' welfare issues shall also be tackled.
