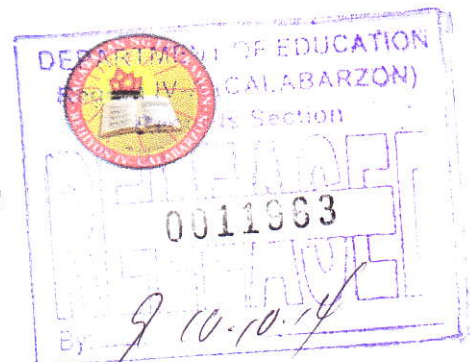

2014 Regional Literacy Conference and Awards

1. In our desire to recognize the significant contributions of numerous stakeholders and advocates of literacy and continuing education that presently undertake literacy programs/projects to address the present problem of illiteracy in the country, this Office through the Curriculum and Learning Management Team will conduct the *2014 Regional Literacy Conference and Awards*.

2. The general objective of this regional awarding is to recognize the best practices in implementing literacy programs/projects which help alleviate poverty, provide livelihood, address welfare needs, promote freedom and make education facilities accessible.

Among its specific objectives are :

- 2.1 Provide a venue for the exchange of good practices and experiences on literacy programs
- 2.2 Sustain, expand and institutionalize literacy efforts by motivating and recognizing individuals, institutions and local government units through awards and appropriate recognition;
- 2.3 Encourage the development and replication of innovative, creative and indigenous Literacy programs; and
- 2.4 Bestow honor and recognition to outstanding individuals, government and non-government organization for their dedication, commitment and contribution to the universalization of literacy in their respective communities.

3. *The 2014 Regional Literacy and Awards will be held on October 23-24, 2014 at Tagaytay International Convention Center (TICC), Tagaytay City, Division of Cavite Province. The Education Program Supervisors (EPS) of the eighteen (18) divisions are expected to be at the venue on October 23, 2014 at 2:00 PM for the preparation of the awarding ceremonies and for a short meeting regarding the*

recently concluded National Literacy Conference held in Baguio City. *The awarding ceremonies will be on October 24, 2014 and will start at exactly 9:00 in the morning.*
