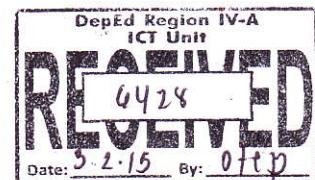

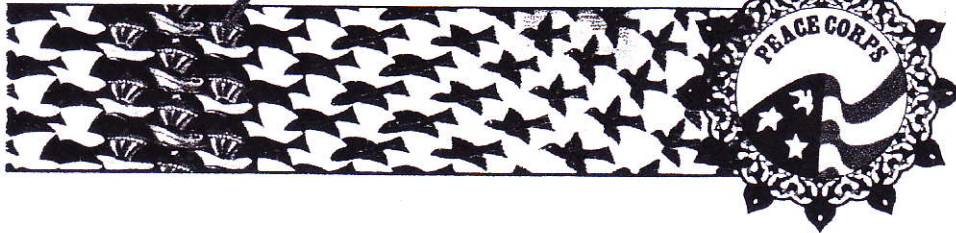

Padayon Mindanao is a continuing partnership of USAID, US Peace Corps and Department of Education to promote peace building in the country. At the core of this education initiative is cross-cultural learning among literacy teachers and youth leaders across conflict affected areas in Mindanao and other Peace Corps sites in the Philippines.

Literacy Summit is an eight-day [including 2 travel days] convention of literacy teachers from Region IX, XII, ARMM and Region IV A CALABARZON. The over-all objective of the Summit is developing competences of literacy teachers to meet the education needs of vulnerable youth through Alternative Learning System by: raising awareness on situations of vulnerable youth in education settings; promoting innovations in teaching strategies and learning assessments as applied to ALS core modules; and, upholding mutual learning among participants and exchange of practices in ALS initiatives across regions.

The program includes course group modules on English Communication Skills in Reading, Writing, Speaking and Listening; Teaching Science & Math; Teaching Civics and History; and, Teaching Environmental Education. There will be plenary presentations and group workshops on Learning Styles, Learning Assessments, Creative Teaching Techniques and ICT for teachers. Literacy teachers will have an opportunity to share ALS good practices through poster presentations and educational tour at selected ALS learning sites of the host region.

All official expenses, including land transport, lodging, and meals will be covered and reimbursed by the Padayon Mindanao Project.
