**GENDER FAIR EDUCATION (GFE)**

**MAY 4 - 8**

GFE is an intensive one-week course designed for development workers and educators in formal and non-formal education (i.e. teachers, administrators, module writers, trainers, etc). The course introduces the gender and development (GAD) and human rights based perspectives in schools and other teaching learning environment. Topics include DepEd and CHED Issuances (i.e. CMOs) on the implementation of GAD in schools and Higher Education Institutions, gender fair language, and gender mainstreaming in the curriculum.

**GENDER RESPONSIVE PLANNING  
 AND BUDGETING (GRP)**

**MAY 18 - 21**

The gender and development (GAD) budgeting process secures financial support for activities promoting gender equality and women's empowerment. Financial support, while necessary, must be complemented by strengthened organizational capacity for successful planning and implementation. This course will introduce the theories and practice of GAD budgeting in the Philippines. In line with PCW-NEDA-DBM Joint Circular No. 2012-01 on GAD Plans and Budgets and Accomplishments to implement Magna Carta of Women. The approach will use case studies and sharing of participants' experiences to enhance learning. The course will be led by Dr. Marina Durano of the UP Asian Center who was involved in the introduction of gender responsive budgeting to local municipalities in Penang, Malaysia.

**INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S HUMAN RIGHTS  
 AND GOVERNANCE (IWHR&G)**

**APRIL 20 - 24**

Running on its 17th year, IWHR&G is a regular academic-based women's human rights course offered in the Philippines. The program discusses the use of international human rights instruments from gender and rights perspectives in analyzing complex issues of discrimination, inequality and oppression brought about by the intersecting factors of class, gender, ethnicity, age, sexual orientation and others.

**SUMMER INSTITUTE ON MIGRATION (SIM)**

**MAY 11 - 15**

SIM provides a critical overview of the processes, dynamics and challenges of migration in the context of a globalized world. The course utilizes interactive and case studies in understanding the complex dimensions of migration. Topics include: gender analysis of migration; comparative migration policies; migration and human rights; marriage migration; social cost of migration; migration and environmental crises; and return and reintegration, among others.

**COURSE FEE:** Php 12,000 (on-site)  
 Php 11,500 (payment made on or before April 30)

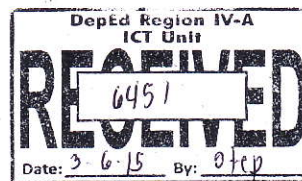
