As we implement the K to 12 curriculum, Learner's Materials (LMs) and Teacher's Guides (TGs) are very important in daily lessons. We are glad to inform you that the Bureau has been working on the development and finalization of the Learner's Material (LM) and Teacher's Guide (TG) for Grades 9 and 10 in TLE. One of the difficulties in delivering the LMs and TGs is not being able to determine the specialization being offered in each school.

Therefore, Secondary Schools are advised to inform the Division and Regional Offices, copy furnished the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), the type of TLE curriculum they have decided to offer.

Information of the course offerings is needed by the BSE as basis for mapping the course offerings of all public secondary schools nationwide. The said data will also be submitted to the Instructional Materials and Council Secretariat (IMCS) for determining the total number of Grade 9 and Grade 10 Learning Material and Teachers Guide for mass production and delivery in your Region/Division / School. Hence, all regions are advised to submit to the BSE (Attn: **Mr. James Julius Liquigan**, EPSII, CDD) the necessary data **on or before March 13, 2015**.

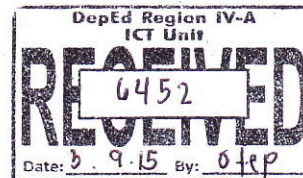
