

**GRADE 10 TECHNOLOGY AND LIVELIHOOD EDUCATION
NATIONAL TRAINING OF TRAINERS (TLE NTOT)**

1. In line with the implementation of the K to 12 Basic Education Program, the Department of Education (DepEd), through the Bureau of Secondary Education (BSE), in coordination with the regional offices (ROs), shall conduct the **Grade 10 Technology and Livelihood Education National Training of Trainers (TLE NTOT)** from April 28 to May 1, 2015 at the Tagaytay International Convention Center (TICC), Tagaytay City.
2. The TLE NTOT aims to familiarize the trainer-participants with the training design and simulate the conduct of the different sessions.
3. The participants are the TLE regional and schools division supervisors/coordinators who are advised to bring their own laptop.
4. Training costs, which cover board and lodging, travel expenses of the management staff, trainers, participants and resource persons, honoraria of resource persons, supplies and materials and other incidental expenses shall be charged to the Human Resource Training and Development (HRTD) Funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Check-in shall be on **April 27, 2015** with dinner as the first meal, and check-out shall be on **May 1, 2015** with breakfast as the last meal.
