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ANNEX A

A. QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Philippine Government

- a. Candidate must have rendered at least three (3) years of service;
- b. Must hold a permanent appointment;
- c. Must have a college degree related to the field of study or has sufficient demonstrated ability and experience along the field of study;
- d. Must have obtained at least a very satisfactory performance rating for two consecutive periods preceding the nomination;
- e. Must not have a pending application for scholarship under another program; and
- f. Must have rendered the service obligation required under Executive Order 367 for scholarship recently concluded before he/she could again be nominated for another course where the field of study is different from the previous training.

B. FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

1. DepEd will provide the salary of the nominee for the duration of the award.
2. BPI Foundation, Inc. will provide for their tuition fees and stipend ranging from PhP 5,000.00 to PhP 15,000.00 a month depending on the location of the school where they will enroll vis-a-vis their place of residence and assignment.

C. DOCUMENTARY REQUIREMENTS (DEPED)

1. Supporting documents to be submitted prior to screening and evaluation:
 - a. A letter of nomination addressed to the Chairman of DepEd Scholarship Committee signed by the Regional Director or its duly authorized official;
 - b. Updated Personal Data Sheet/Resume with list of in-service training and seminars attended (Spell out acronyms of organizer/s and topic/s or subject/s of the training; certificates of training **NEED NOT** be submitted);
 - c. Certified copy of service record;
 - d. Certified copy of statement of actual duties and responsibilities.
2. Other documentary requirements to be submitted **if accepted**:
 - a. Photocopy of Diploma (Baccalaureate/graduate);
 - b. Photocopy of Transcript of Records (Baccalaureate/graduate);
 - c. Certification that the nominee has no pending scholarship nomination to other program;
 - d. Certification that the nominee has no pending administrative and criminal case;
 - e. Certification from the school/division that the nominee has no financial and office accountabilities;
 - f. Scholarship Contract.



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D. PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS (BPI Foundation, Inc.)

- a. Must have very satisfactory or outstanding performance rating for the last 2 years;
- b. With teaching experience of at least five (5) years;
- c. Not more than 35 years old;
- d. Must teach in the same school for two and a half (2 & 1/2) years for every year of scholarship;
- e. No pending administrative case and a person of good moral character.
