

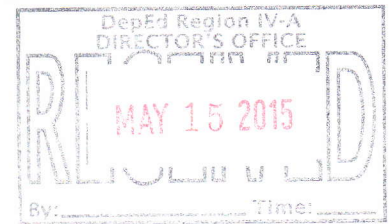

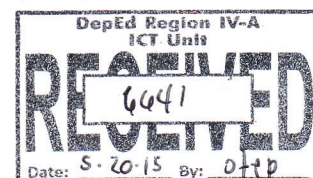
SUBJECT: MODIFIED CONDITIONAL CASH TRANSFER (MCCT)  
PROGRAM

DATE: 07 May 2015

This is to inform you that the Pantawid Pamilyang Pilipino Program National Program Management Office (Pantawid NPMO) has crafted a program termed Modified Conditional Cash Transfer (MCCT) program. The beneficiaries of the program are the poor, disadvantaged and vulnerable sector of the society which includes homeless street families, indigenous people in geographically isolated and disadvantaged areas and families who are not covered by the regular Pantawid Pamilya Pilipino Program.

The strategy of MCCT is same with the regular Conditional Cash Transfer (CCT) but with modification in terms of processes. The program intends to provide cash grants (education and health) to eligible families following the set conditionalities of the program. As part of the conditionalities of the program, MCCT beneficiaries should comply with the program conditions on Health, Education and Family Development Sessions. Conditionalities are designed to improve their social and health outcomes as well as to transform towards positive outlook in life and commitments. For education, each child beneficiary must observe the prescribed school attendance set by the program.

The program has a separate Case Workers/Community Facilitators (equivalent to City/Municipal Link) as field implementers. The MCCT has also a separate database system and for this, there will be a separate compliance verification timeline from the Pantawid Pamilya Pilipino Program. This will entail for a separate CV form to be accomplished in the schools. To date, the MCCT has a total of 218,377 beneficiaries nationwide.



In this connection, all Regional Directors and Schools Division Superintendents are instructed to disseminate the information in the field considering that monitoring of compliance for education of the MCCT beneficiaries is on-going.

All Regional Directors and Schools Division Superintendent are enjoined to support this undertaking.

Immediate attention and strict compliance to this Memorandum are desired.
