With the blessing and cooperation of the Department of Education, the Philippine Professional Linkage from Various Discipline, Inc. will conduct an **International Training / Seminar / Workshop on Appraisal School Leaders** with the theme: "**Fostering Pedagogical Leadership in Schools Across Cultures**" on **August 7- 9 , 2015 at Romulo Hall, Teacher's Camp, Baguio City and August 14 – 16 at Batangas Province.**

I. Rationale:

Research shows that policy makers have increasingly recognized the significance of school leadership for effective teaching and learning. Within that context many countries all over the world have made initiatives to strengthen the leadership capacity of their schools. Research on this effect is limited, some evidence suggest potential benefits of the appraisal of individual school leaders as a means to communicate a vision of effective leadership and a tool to influence and improve school leaders' practices and behaviors.

This seminar will tackle on the approaches that countries take to appraise individual school leaders. Building on a conceptualism of school leadership and a discussion of drivers and contextual developments it analyzes the governance of appraisal schemes, appraisal procedures, the capacity required for effective appraisal and the use of appraisal results. The seminar will be useful to leaders for coming-up of pointers for future policy development.

II. Dates & Venue: **August 7- 9 , 2015 at Romulo Hall, Teacher's Camp, Baguio City. August 14 – 16, 2015 at Batangas Province (TBAL).**

III. The Seminar Aims to:

1. Come-up with conceptualization of a holistic approach to evaluation and assessment for the role of school leaders for teacher appraisal and school evaluation.
2. Analyze countries current approaches to the appraisal of individual school leaders and the ways in which appraisal can contribute to improving teaching and learning in schools.
3. Know the potential benefits of appraisal as a tool for improving school leadership.
4. Discover the different in-depth analysis of approaches to school leaders and develop a conceptual framework for sub-sequent analysis.
