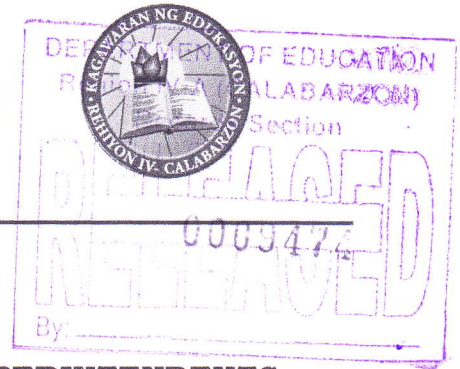

 ON THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NATIONAL
 SCHOOL DEWORMING DAY (NSDD) and NOTIFICATION
 LETTER**

DATE: June 30, 2015

(1) The Department of Health (DOH) in partnership with the Department of Education (DepED) will be conducting the National School Deworming Day (NSDD) on July 29, 2015 which will involve simultaneous intake of the deworming tablet at 10 AM all over the country.

This concerted effort of deworming children in schools has been found to be a good strategy to reduce the burden of Soil Transmitted Helminthiasis (STH) infections with a positive impact on children's education and health. However, we have not reached the 85% Mass Deworming Activity (MDA) coverage. Thus, we need to scale up efforts in providing health services for school children through the NSDD.
