We hope for your support to make this event truly productive and successful.

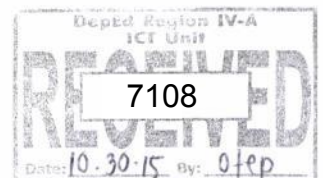


