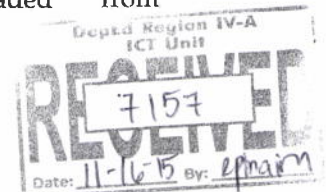

1. The Development Academy of the Philippines announces the opening of the nominations to the **Senior Executives Class (SEC) of the Public Management Development Program**. The revised SEC is a compact course on public management delivered in 2-week segments per month over three months.
2. The training consists of a total of 24 days intensive residential training at the Development Academy of the Philippines in Tagaytay City, a ten (10)-day sensing journey in a rural community and a five (5)-day foreign study mission in an ASEAN-member country. Participants are expected to submit either a policy paper or a management case at the end of the course.
3. The criteria and qualifications for Senior Executives Class are the following:
 - a. Non-CESO incumbents and officers-in-charge of SG 25 positions and above
 - b. 55 years old and below
 - c. Very satisfactory or Outstanding performance rating for the past two years
 - d. Possesses managerial and leadership potential with good character
 - e. Must have excellent oral and written communication skills
 - f. Must be in good health condition
 - g. Willing to sign a service contract up to two years after completing the program
4. Each bureau, service, and region is requested to send four (4) nominees noting the criteria and qualifications for selection of participants (see attached Annex A). Nominees endorsed by the Department will undergo the preliminary screening, examination, and interview to be conducted by DAP. Successful applicants will receive full government scholarships.
