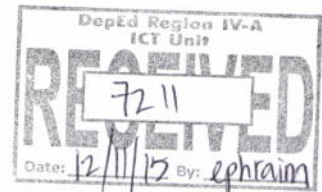

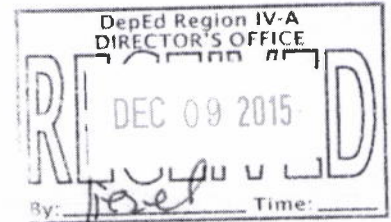

GUIDELINES

A. BACKGROUND

In November 1999, Republic Act 8757 was passed establishing the Philippine Sports Hall of Fame.

On May 5, 2010, the Hall of Fame ceremony was organized by the Philippine Olympians Association with Arturo Macapagal as chair, and then PSC Chairman as vice chair. The first batch of Hall of Fame inductees were the following:

B. OBJECTIVES

1. To enshrine Filipino athletes, coaches and trainers who have distinguished themselves in their particular field of sports.
2. To preserve and celebrate the Filipino sportsman's highest achievements in sports and life, inspiring the next generation to aspire for their highest potential in both sports and life.

C. COMMITTEES

Screening and Selection Committee (SSC)

A screening, selection and decision making body to ensure that proceedings are properly conducted. The Committee shall review the list of nominees endorsed by the Project Management Committee and elect from among the nominees the 20 awardees for the second batch of Hall of Fame. The composition of the SSC is as follows:

Sub-Committee on Screening and Selection

The Sub-Committee shall assist the Screening and Selection Committee in reviewing the list of nominees endorsed by the Project Management Committee. It may also provide factual information and inputs which shall serve as guide in electing the 20 awardees. The composition of the Sub-Committee is as follows:

Project Management Committee (PMC)

The Project Management Committee shall receive, accept, collate and keep records of all nominations and other documents submitted to the Screening and Selection Committee (SSC) including records, meetings or consultations. The Committee shall provide technical and administrative assistance to SSC in the conduct of meetings or consultations. It shall also handle the whole process of screening and evaluation of credentials of all the nominees to produce a list for endorsement to the SSC. The composition of the Committee is as follows:

D. STEP-BY-STEP PROCESS

Step 1 Nomination by formal entities

- 1.1 Selected government entities, non-government organizations, national sports associations, universities, and distinguished individuals in the field of sports shall be invited to nominate 20 athletes/coaches/trainers to the second batch of Hall of Fame.
- 1.2 First batch awardees (CY 2010) are not allowed to be nominated or elected again for the Second Batch of Hall of Fame.
- 1.3 Nominations shall cover the period 1924-1974.

1.4 A nominee must meet any one of the following requirements and standards to qualify:

Sports Achievement, based on RA 8757 (Mandatory requirement)

- a. Gold medal in any Southeast Asian Games.
- b. At least a Silver medal in the Asian Games or Asian Cup or regional games.
- c. At least a Bronze medal in the Olympic Games or World Games.
- d. A World Champion (amateur and professional sports).

Step 2 Assessment of nominees

2.1 All nominees shall be background checked for any infraction and cross-checked in terms of sports achievement by the Project Management Committee. Qualified nominees shall be rated using the following parameters and points system:

1. On Sports Achievement

	Gold	Silver	Bronze
South East Asian Games	2 points	--	--
Asian Games or Asian Cup or Regional Games	6 points	4 points	--
Olympic Games or World Games	10 points	8 points	6 points
World Champion (amateur and professional sports)	10 points		

Note: All achievements of the nominees within the specified period (D 1.3) shall be included in the remarks.

2. On Personal Background

Criminal & Civil Case	Notation on the background information
Service to the Philippine Government or NSA	
Other contributions and/or achievements in sports	

3. On Multiple Nominations

Step 3 Submission of list of nominees

The Project Management Committee shall endorse to the Screening and Selection Committee and its Sub-Committee all evaluated nominees with appropriate rating based on result of the point system, as provided in Step 2.

Step 4 Deliberation and election of 20 Hall of Fame Awardees


The Screening and Selection Committee and its Sub-Committee shall deliberate all the nominees based on merits, credentials, background information and remarks. The Committee shall elect 20 nominees from among the long list to be enshrined as the second batch of Hall of Fame Awardees.

E. ENTITLEMENTS OF HALL OF FAME AWARDEES

The 20 Hall of Fame Awardees shall be entitled to the following:

- a. Inclusion in the Roll of Hall of Fame Awardees.
- b. Enshrinement of sports memorabilia in the Sports Hall of Fame Building.
- c. P100,000 cash prize from the Philippine Sports Commission.
