In this connection, we would like to invite your supervisors, school heads, coordinators, advisers and teachers to attend and learn from the said seminar-workshops.

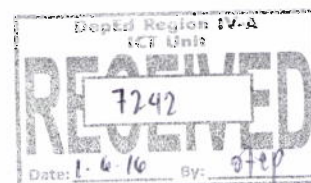


