This event is scheduled on **February 29, 2016 (Monday)** at the **College of Economics and Management, UPLB from 8:00 AM to 5:00 PM**.



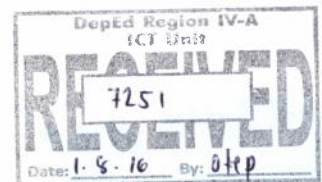

## RULES AND REGULATIONS

### APPLICATION

- 1 Any recognized high school in the area covered under **CALABARZON** and **NCR**, with a group of students, may participate in the 16th Annual Mind gAEMS.
- 2 Five students shall represent each participating school: two students for the quiz contest and one student for each of the other events.
- 3 Fully accomplished participant's profile shall be submitted on the day of the event (February 29, 2016).
- 4 There will be **NO REGISTRATION FEE** for each participating schools.

### INTRICACIES OF THE COMPETITION

#### ECONOMIC QUIZ CONTEST



- 1 The quiz contest will consist of questions pertaining to **basic economic principles/issues, current events and general information**.
- 2 The contest will be divided into two levels - the average and the difficult round. Each round will consist of 15 questions. In case of a tie, there will be a clincher round. It will consist of 3 questions.
- 3 UP AEMS will be providing official answer sheets for the contestants.
- 4 After reading the questions twice, a signal will be given for the contestants to answer within 10 seconds. The answer will be announced only after the proctor has collected the answer sheets.
- 5 The top 3 scorers will be awarded as 1st, 2nd, and 3rd places, respectively.
- 6 **Coaching is strictly prohibited during the contest proper.**

5 Point system is as follows:

|                | average  | difficult | clincher  |

| correct answer | 3 points | 5 points  | 7 points  |
| wrong answer   | 0 points | 0 points  | -1 point  |
| no answer      | -1 point | -2 points | -3 points |

## ESSAY WRITING CONTEST

- 1 The essay will be based on the theme to be given by the proctor. The theme will be announced at the start of the contest.
- 2 The essay must be written legibly on the paper to be provided by the proctor. It should contain at least 200 words. The medium to be used is English.
- 3 The contestants are given 1 1/2 hours. Finished or not finished, the essay should be passed to the proctor after the allotted time.
- 4 The contest will be judged based on the following criteria:

## POSTER MAKING CONTEST



- 1 The theme for the poster making contest will be given by the proctor before the contest proper.
- 2 The contestants will need to bring their own drawing materials. Illustration boards will be provided.
- 3 The contest will last for 1 1/2 hours. Finished or not finished, the posters should be passed to the proctors.
- 4 The contest will be judged based on the following criteria:

## IMPROMPTU PUBLIC SPEAKING CONTEST



1. The turn of each speaker will be determined by drawing of lots. The proctor will only give the theme of speech to the current speaker. **The contestants will be given 3 minutes to prepare and 5 minutes to deliver the speech in English.**
2. The remaining contestants will be isolated from the place of the speech in order not to hear the ideas of the current speaker.
3. The contest will be judged based on the following criteria:

4. The 1st, 2nd, and 3rd winners will receive medals.

## WINNING SCHOOLS

The participating schools will be ranked accordingly in every contest. Determination of the winners will be based on their general weighted rank. The **top 3 schools** will be declared as **Champion, 1st Runner-Up** and **2nd Runner-Up**. Each will receive a **trophy** and a cash prize worth **Php2,500, Php2,000** and **Php1,500**, respectively.
