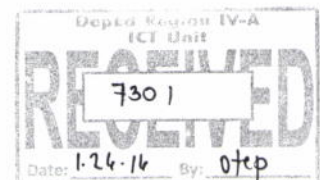
The forum aims to emphasize on population and family as assets and ultimate resources of society, and how to strengthen the family so that this human resource does not become a liability.

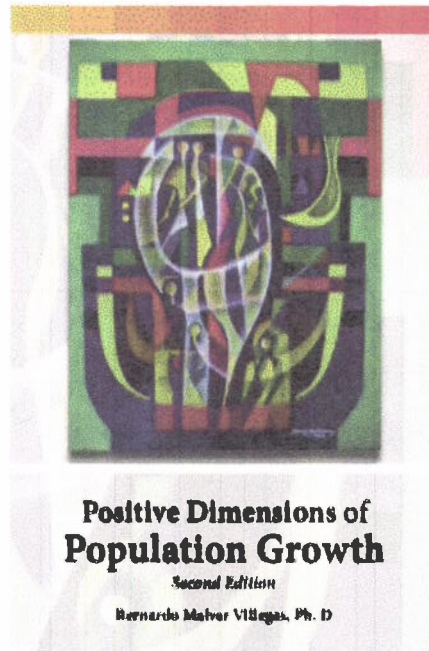
