Each participant shall be charged a registration fee of Five Thousand Pesos (Php5,000.00) to cover expenses for food, conference materials, kits and other related expenses.

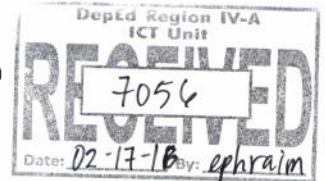
