National Association of Physical Educators (NAPE) membership fee is Php 500.00 for lifetime member of the association. Payment be done during the registration.

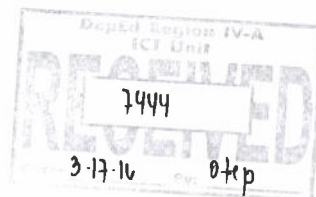
