





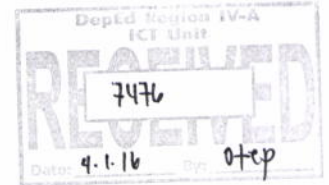

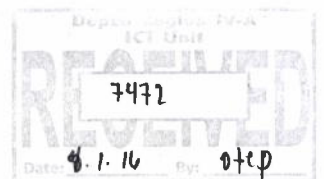

We tried to give each Region at least one scholar . Other Regions were given more than the intended two just to have a sufficient number of scholars because the tests of their applicants are relatively good. To enable us to give each Region at least one, there is one in the list that got below 20 points but the Transcript of Records, indicate that the applicant can at least pass if he works hard.

The scores of applicants from some Regions are relatively good while those from others are relatively weak, though undergraduate records are good. To succeed better for next year, we recommend that the Division will implement the Saturday DepEd-MTAP Programs especially that for the talented students.

For Regions, who have a graduate of the first group of scholars , we recommend that they be asked to train other teachers.
