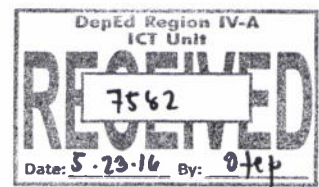

I. Seminar Objectives:

1. Social Studies teachers will be able to understand how to teach History from a Civic Education perspective.
2. Social Studies teachers will be able to gain new insights about the History curriculum's essential content.
3. Social Studies teachers will be able to apply various reading-to-learn and formative assessment techniques and strategies in teaching History.
4. Social Studies teachers will be able to craft a lesson exemplar in teaching History using a Civic Education perspective.

Seminar Description:

This two day seminar will focus on helping the Grade School and High School Social Studies teacher learn how to teach in an exemplary manner. Effectively teaching Social Studies particularly History requires that a teacher understands the essential content and how to teach the lessons. The essential content will be discussed in day one of the seminar which include new insights and big ideas about Philippine History, Asian History, and World History. In day two, the focus will shift to pedagogy which includes sessions on understanding how students learn history, using reading-to-learn strategies, and reflecting on the use of feedback to help students grapple with the challenges of learning History. Finally, the training program will culminate in a workshop/writeshop wherein the Social Studies teachers will have the opportunity to apply what they have learned.
