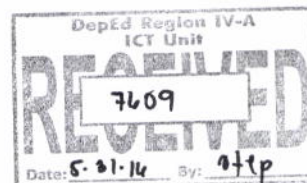
Being CHED accredited, we are able to credit this study for graduate level for 3 units for an elective course.
