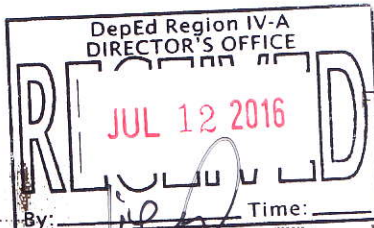

Dear RD San Antonio:

In line with One Meralco Foundation's Energy Education Program, it is now set to replicate the creation of Energy Flashcards nationwide by giving opportunities to classroom teachers to participate in a year-long enhancement and learning program on content development.

On this note, OMF and its implementing partner, Coalition for Better Education, will be conducting a series of roadshows starting July to August of this year to introduce the Energy Flashcards to public school teachers and principals in six major areas/cities in the country. Another objective of the roadshow is to invite teachers to participate in an energy data-banking program through flashcard making. Teachers whose flashcards are selected to be included in the 'energy data bank' will qualify to participate in a series of trainings on content development that will commence in October in time for the celebration of the World Teachers Day.

On the one hand, sessions on how to sustain Energy Programs in schools will also be one of the highlights in the roadshows.

Target participants are the schools division superintendents and selected school principals and teachers per division. A selection criteria for teachers who will participate in the roadshow is provided.

The roadshow is a one-day event that will start at 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. Transportation and other local travel expenses shall be charged against the school's MOOE while meals shall be shouldered by OMF.

Attached are the following: Program of the Roadshow, List of divisions and the selection criteria for teachers who will participate in the event. As we are only limiting the number of participants to 100 pax per roadshow, we would appreciate if the attached number of participants per area be strictly followed.

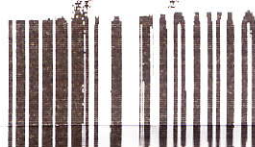
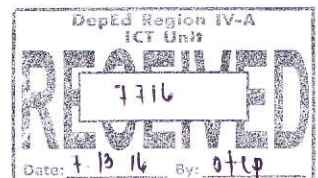

Selection Criteria for Participating Teachers

1. Teaching Experience: at least 2-year experience as a teacher in the elementary or high school level;
2. Age: Between 24 – 55 years old;
3. Health: In healthy condition, not suffering from any disease, has not been admitted to the hospital in the last six months. Able to present a clean bill from a certified medical doctor;
4. Education/training: preference for those not currently enrolled in any graduate/post-graduate courses.
5. Education/training: has been trained on Project-based Learning (PBL) Approaches, Outcomes-based Education (OBE), Understanding by Design (UBD) - PREFERRED;
6. Computer Skills:
 - a. With intermediate to advanced ICT/digital literacy skills specifically slide presentations;
 - b. Always online at least four to six times a week, average of two to three hours per day;
7. ICT Access:
 - a. owns a laptop or computer unit- VERY IMPORTANT!;
 - b. has regular access to internet facilities or has internet facility at home and/or school- VERY IMPORTANT;
8. Commitment:
 - a. Submit the required number of flashcards for the Energy Data Bank Program;
 - b. Participate actively in the Deep-Dive Session called Energy Summit in October;
 - c. Support the project and respond to the project owners regularly either F2F or online for at least one year;
 - d. Be a partner in advocating the use of flashcards to teach about Energy and its related topics in the community.

The following are the topics to be discussed during the Roadshow:

1. Practicing Energy Efficiency in Schools;
2. Sustaining Energy Programs in Schools;
3. Integrating Energy Education in Schools Using OMF Flashcards;
4. Developing Customized Energy Flashcards; and
5. Art of Questioning, Project-based Learning Approaches, ICT Integration.

The target participants are school heads/principals, teachers and schools division superintendents from public elementary or secondary schools.

Participation of public schools shall be subject to the *no disruption-of-classes policy* stipulated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 entitled *Instituting Measures to Increase Engaged Time-on-Task and Ensuring Compliance Therewith*.
