





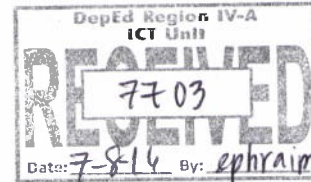

SUBJECT : 2016 ORIENTATION ON THE SCHOOL-BASED FEEDING GUIDELINES

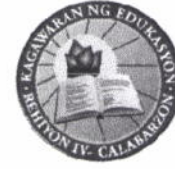
The Department of Education through the Bureau of Learner Support Services, School Health Division in coordination with DepEd CALABARZON, Education Support Services has been implementing the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) for the past six years. To make sure that the feeding program meets its objectives, an annual program evaluation was conducted which indicated that 75% of the undernourished student beneficiaries convert to normal nutritional status at the end of 120 feeding days. School attendance was also noted to be improved and averaged at 95%. The children were observed to have better class participation and exhibited positive health habits as washing of hands before and after eating, tooth brushing; general good grooming behavior and inculcates the values of praying before and after meals.

This school year 2016-2017, DepEd will continue to implement the DepEd funded SBFP in accordance with the General Appropriations Act (GAA) of 2016 under the Republic Act (RA) 1065. This will cover 115,326 severely wasted (SW) and 237,667 wasted (W) learners in public elementary schools in CALABARZON. In this context, an orientation-workshop of SBFP focal persons and implementers will be conducted on July 18-19, 2016 at NEAP, Malvar Batangas. This orientation workshop aims to orient the participants on the salient points of the 2016 sbfp guidelines, review the status of the program in their divisions and come up with future plans for the improvement of the program.

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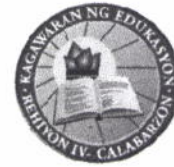
