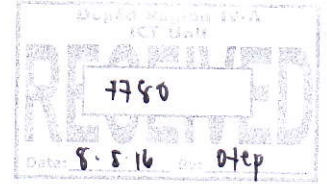

The Dangerous Drug Board (DDB) will conduct the Story-Telling Competition pursuant to Article 4 Section 43 of the Republic Act 9164 stating that the DDB is mandated to develop programs on drug abuse prevention and control and to disseminate the same to the general public. This is part of the civic awareness activities intended for public elementary school students aiming to enhance the talent of children in story-telling, at the same time introduce the concept of drug abuse prevention among grade school pupils. Winners will be invited to perform during various DDB activities for children.

Therefore, through this Office, we invite one (1) representative per Division with the complete name, age, school, grade level, 2x 2 picture on white background and one accompanying (1) coach/adviser with complete name, designation, 2 x 2 picture on white background to be emailed to ess_calabarzon@yahoo.com before September 9, 2016 (Friday).

Competition will be on September 23, 2016 at 9:00 AM, venue to be determined. Contest mechanics is hereby enclosed.

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CONTEST MECHANICS:

- The competition is open only to Primary Schools within Region IV-A.
- There should be only one representative and a coach (adviser) per Division of City Schools.
- The theme of the competition is *“Listen First: Listening to children and youth is the first step to help them grow healthy and safe”*.
- The language to be use for the competition is Tagalog.
- Genres that may be used are historical tales, oral histories, family stories, personal stories, and proverbs which are not necessarily written by the contestants.
- Contestants will have seven (7) minutes for the presentation of the story.
- The organizers will provide a countdown timer visible to everyone for fairness and transparency.
- Contestants should memorize their piece/story.
- Contestants are allowed to use props/costume.
- Contestants must provide three (3) copies of the story (on 8 1/2” by 11” white paper, double spaced, in Times New Roman (Font style), 12 point (font size) on the day of the competition.
- Time will start when the contestant first speaks.
- The judges will signal time to the participant(s) using flags:
 - ✓ **Green flag:** the participant begins his/her story telling.
 - ✓ **Red flag:** the time is up [Seven (7) minutes = maximum time].
 - ✓ 15 seconds will be given as a grace period after the 7 minute.
 - ✓ If the story has not yet been finished, the judges will give 5 knocks to signal that time is up.
 - ✓ The grace period will affect the score; every second past the tolerance time will **reduce** the score by 1 point.
- The competition will start at 9:00 a.m. on September 23, 2016, at a venue within San Mateo, Rizal.
- The criteria for judging includes:

✓ Content (Story is delivered in logical order and is appropriate to the theme)	= 30%
✓ Pronunciation (Articulation and Intonation)	= 15%
✓ Fluency (Pace, Voice Quality, Vocal Expression)	= 15%
✓ Stage Performance (Confidence, Gesture, Mimicry)	= 15%
✓ Creativity	= 15%
✓ Time Management	= 10%

- Winners of the competition will receive trophies and cash prizes, to wit:
 - ✓ 1st Place Winner - P15,000.00
 - ✓ 2nd Place Winner - P10,000.00
 - ✓ 3rd Place Winner - P5,000.00
 - ✓ 10% of the amount will be given to the coach(winner).
 - ✓ Consolation Prize – P1,000.00 – non-winners
- The decision of the judges together with the DDB representatives shall be final and unappealable.
- The winner will be invited to perform their piece during the DDB activities for children.
- Awarding of prizes is on the same date of the competition.
