**INDUSTRY SUMMIT ON THE PROJECT FOR SUPPORTING  
THE SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL PROGRAM**

1. The Department of Education–Bureau of Curriculum Development (DepEd–BCD), in collaboration with the Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA) Project Team, will conduct the **Industry Summit** from November 7 to 9, 2016 at the Ace Hotel and Suites, Brixton St., near Pioneer, United St., Pasig City.

2. The Industry Summit aims to share the lessons learned on industry partnership and work immersion with selected recipient technical-vocational (Tech-Voc) schools under the **Project for Supporting the Senior High School (SHS) Program**, through a Memorandum of Understanding between the DepEd and JICA signed on September 30, 2013. Specifically, it aims to:

- a. share with the industries updates on the SHS implementation;
- b. share good practices and experiences of model schools with other Tech-Voc secondary schools;
- c. facilitate network building and partnership between schools and industries;
- d. recommend policy agenda related to industry partnership; and
- e. develop industry partnership-related action plans for each school in support to SHS student immersion and placement.

3. The participating schools and offices are listed in Enclosure No. 1. They are composed of the following:

- a. Chiefs of the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) or representatives from the 17 DepEd Regional Offices;
- b. School Heads of the 280 public Tech-Voc secondary schools;
- c. Representatives of major industries, their associations and public sector;
- d. DepEd BCD Management and Resource Persons; and
- e. JICA Project Team.

4. Registration and billeting of the participants will start from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon on **November 7** with p.m. snack as the first meal. Check-out time will be at 1:00 p.m. on **November 9, 2016**. Participants are advised to register online through this URL link: **<https://goo.gl/forms/omRObdFNOLXUrqzq1>** or to submit the accomplished Participant's Profile provided in Enclosure No. 2 through email address at **[ma.nayve@deped.gov.ph](mailto:ma.nayve@deped.gov.ph)** on or before **October 28, 2016**.

5. The JICA Project will pay for the board and lodging, supplies and materials, and other related expenses, while the BCD will shoulder the travel expenses and per diem of the participants, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. Travel authorities, official receipts i.e. bus/plane tickets, and other travel documents shall be submitted to the BCD Finance Committee for reimbursement.
