**FIRST RONDALLA MUSIC CAMP**

To: Regional Directors  
Schools Division Superintendents  
Public Elementary and Secondary Schools Heads  
All Others Concerned

1. The National Commission for Culture and the Arts (NCCA), through the National Music Competitions for Young Artists (NAMCYA) and the Musicological Society of the Philippines (MSP), will conduct the **First Rondalla Music Camp** from July 8 to 23, 2017 in Baguio City, Benguet. The Music Camp will focus on enhancing the proficiency of rondalla practitioners.
2. The Rondalla Music Camp hopes to gather 130 rondalla practitioners: musicians, conductors, arrangers, composers for two weeks to undergo an intensive training on different aspects of rondalla performance and its practice in general.
3. Topics and lessons include Music Theory, Music Analysis, Music History, Writing for Rondalla, Conducting and Playing Techniques of banduria, octavina, laud, mandola, guitar, bass and percussion instruments.
4. Training and education will be offered *free* to the rondalla musicians and practitioners who will pass the screening. Scholars will be selected through an audition process set by the MSP and NAMCYA. The Faculty of the Rondalla Music Camp, headed by Dr. Ramon P. Santos, National Artist for Music, is composed of the best rondalla musicians, eminent educators and accomplished musicians of the country.
5. Teachers and students of elementary and secondary schools are encouraged to apply. If accepted, they will be given a special consideration and will be excused from their classes for the duration of the Music Camp, through this Memorandum.
6. The regular registration fee is *waived* to all accepted scholars of the Music Camp. Learning and instructional materials will also be given for *free*. Accommodation and food for the duration of the Camp will also be provided *free* of charge. However, accepted scholars will be responsible for their own travel expenses going to and from Baguio City.

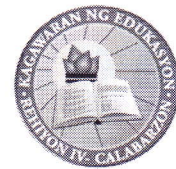

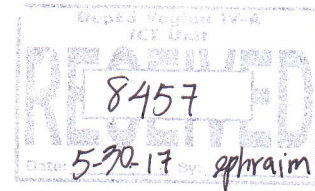
