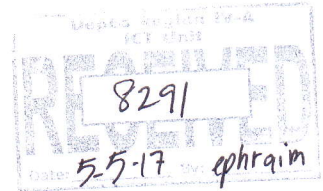

This activity aims to develop indigenized lesson plans for Kindergarten to Grade 3 for the 3rd and 4th quarters.

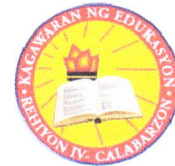
