1. The Southeast Asian Ministers of Education Organization Regional Center for Educational Innovation and Technology (SEAMEO INNOTECH) in partnership with DepEd Region IV-A (CALABARZON) invites participants to attend the Guro21 for Classroom Teachers.
2. The course known as GURO21 or Gearing Up Responsible and Outstanding Teachers in Southeast Asia for the 21<sup>st</sup> Century enable the participants to:
  - a. equip themselves with the knowledge, skills, attitudes, and values (KSAVs) required of 21<sup>st</sup> century teachers that they can pass on to their students to help them face the challenges of 21<sup>st</sup> century; and
  - b. develop and enhance their facilitating skills to effectively play their role as teachers in the 21<sup>st</sup> century.
3. The Participants to this activity are classroom teachers:
  - a. whose School Heads are graduates of TEACHxCELS or those who will be recommended by the School Heads / SDO;
  - b. who are preferably not more than 50 years of age;
  - c. who are computer literate and have easy access to internet connection (required to enable participation in the online course);
  - d. who are able to understand, speak, and write in the English language;
  - e. who are able and willing to utilize course lessons, and share them, with other teachers and their school heads; and
  - f. with minimum of 3 years in the service.
4. The total cost of this program is Php 7,000.00 per participant which covers registration fee, costs of meals / snacks to be served during the face-to-face portions of the course which can be charged against MOOE / Local Fund subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations, as well as transportation costs of the participants to and from the training venue.
