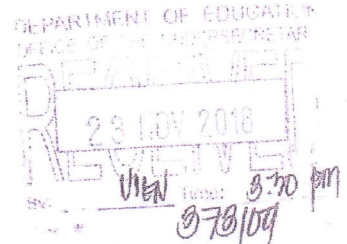

The Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP)'s Public Management Development Program (PMDP), the National Government's Career Executive Service Development Program, is now accepting nominations for its Middle Managers Class (MMC) Batch 20 which starts on 22 February 2019.

The program is designed for high-performing and high-potential section and division chiefs who show promise of assuming bigger responsibilities in the bureaucracy, and exhibit strength in interpersonal skills and serving people. Nominees for the PMDP-MMC must be officials holding permanent positions with Salary Grade 20-24, aged 50 years old or younger, and in good health.

The deadline for submission of nominations is on **21 December** with the following reminders:

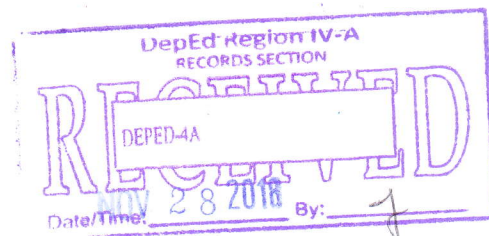
- a. Each region and Central Office strand are advised to nominate two (2) candidates.
- b. Required documents must be submitted via email at scholarships@deped.gov.ph.

Accepted applicants will receive a scholarship grant from the government, through DAP. Scholars who complete all modules are given a Certificate of Completion of Residential Training. A Diploma in Development Management is also given to those who complete the modules, and have an approved Re-Entry Project (ReP) Plan. MMC scholars who complete the implementation of their projects are conferred a Master in Development Management degree.
