Regional Memorandum

PIVOT ASSESSMENT FOR LEARNERS IN DISTANCE LEARNING

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. To continue the effort towards achieving aligned and focused interventions and advanced handholding initiatives, DepEd CALABARZON thru the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), announces the administration of **PIVOT ASSESSMENT FOR LEARNERS IN DISTANCE LEARNING** on April 4-23, 2021.
2. The ultimate goal of PIVOT Assessment for Learners in Distance Learning is to assess teaching and learning processes and identify the necessary gaps in terms of curriculum and instruction, learning delivery and learning resources management. Specifically, this activity aims to:
 - a) gather dependable information regarding academic progress and achievement of learners in distance learning in Quarters 1 and 2 of the school year 2020-2021;
 - b) identify strong points and areas of improvement of the various elements and components of teaching and learning process in the context of distance learning; and
 - c) identify needs of teachers and school administrators to design and develop enrichment, intervention, and remediation plan for learners.
3. PIVOT assessment is a pen and paper test designed for Grade 6, Grade 10 and Grade 12 learners in public elementary and secondary schools. It covers the following subject areas:

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4. PIVOT Assessment is open to all enrolled Grade 6, Grade 10 and Grade 12 learners in school year 2020-2021. Participation to this activity is purely on **voluntary basis**. Interested learners shall register online using the links in Enclosure D and secure a signed parent's consent form (please see Enclosure A). Online Registration is until **March 25, 2021 at 5:00 in the afternoon**. Registration will automatically close once the target number of participants is reached. For learners who do not have internet access, registration will be done thru the class adviser.
5. Due to emerging concerns in increasing number of cases of COVID-19, only learners in municipalities categorized as non-high-risk area by the IATF are allowed to participate in the activity.
6. Testing Coordinators of schools shall submit a master list (please see Enclosure B) of interested learners which shall be validated by District Supervisors and forwarded by the Division Testing Coordinator to the Regional Office at assessmentkra4@gmail.com on **March 29, 2021 at 5:00 in the afternoon**.
7. PIVOT Assessment for Learners in Distance Learning is plotted in a 2-day schedule and time allotment as follows.

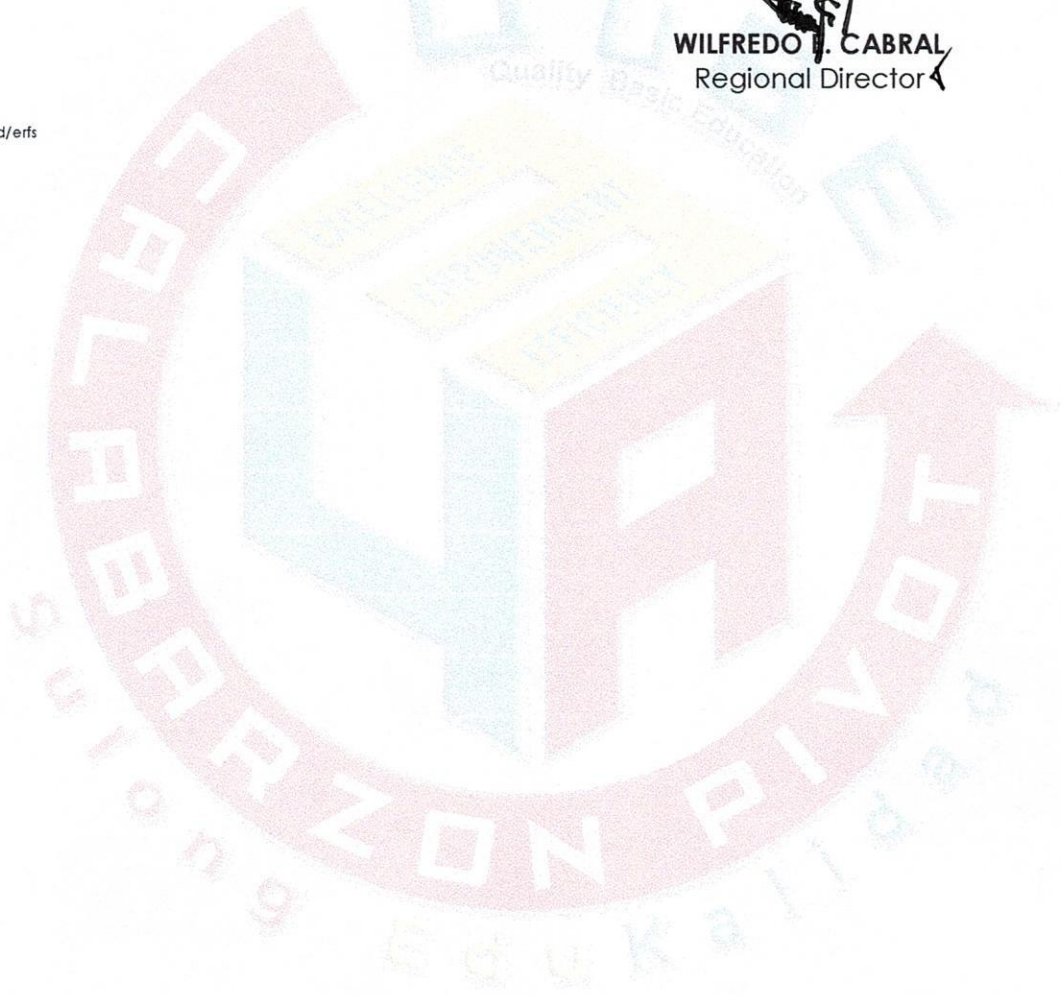
9. School Principals and District Supervisors of participating learners shall provide a list of teachers who will serve as examiner/proctor for the activity (please see Enclosure C). Assignment of examiner/proctor shall be strategically set considering the time allotted for travel/transportation. Submission of said document is on **March 30, 2021 at 5:00 in the afternoon**. Details of online orientation of School Principals, Public School District Supervisors and teachers included in the activity will be announced thru a separate memorandum.
10. PIVOT assessment will be administered at the comfort of the participating learner's home by authorized personnel from DepEd CALABARZON, observing minimum health protocol by the Inter-Agency Task Force for Emerging Infectious Diseases. SDO's are also encouraged to establish communication with the concerned Local Government Units (LGU's) for support in the administration of the assessment and sustainability mechanism.
