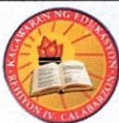

6. Umiray River in between Dingalan, Aurora and General Nakar, Quezon

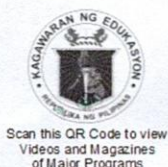
This effort is in line with DepEd's goal of helping preserve and restore the ecosystem of reservoirs and river basins that supply water to Metro Manila and to the provinces.
