**WORKSHOP ON THE DESIGN AND DEVELOPMENT OF PIVOT ASSESSMENT  
FOR LEARNERS IN DISTANCE LEARNING**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**

1. With a consistent end in mind that curriculum and instruction should be coupled with valid and reliable assessment, DepEd CALABARZON, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD), moves towards advancing interventions toward improving Key Result Area 4 – Assessment of Learning Outcomes and its mandates, such as an efficient assessment which is necessary to achieve improved learning processes. This Office announces the conduct of **Workshop on the Design and Development of PIVOT Assessment for Learners in Distance Learning** on February 15-19, 2021 (Phase 1) at a venue to be announced in a separate memorandum and February 24-26, 2021 (Phase 2) through an online platform.
2. This activity aims to develop quality assured assessment tools essential for the instructional design of CALABARZON PIVOT SLMs.  
Specifically, it aims to:
  - a. recalibrate the assessment skills of participants in the context of distance learning; and
  - b. develop and validate assessment tools for distance learning that can capture and measure the achievement of learners of the Most Essential Learning Competencies for Key Stages 3 and 4 in all learning areas.
3. Relative to this, participants must secure laptops, external hard drive, extension wires and other gadgets and devices necessary in their involvement in the activities.

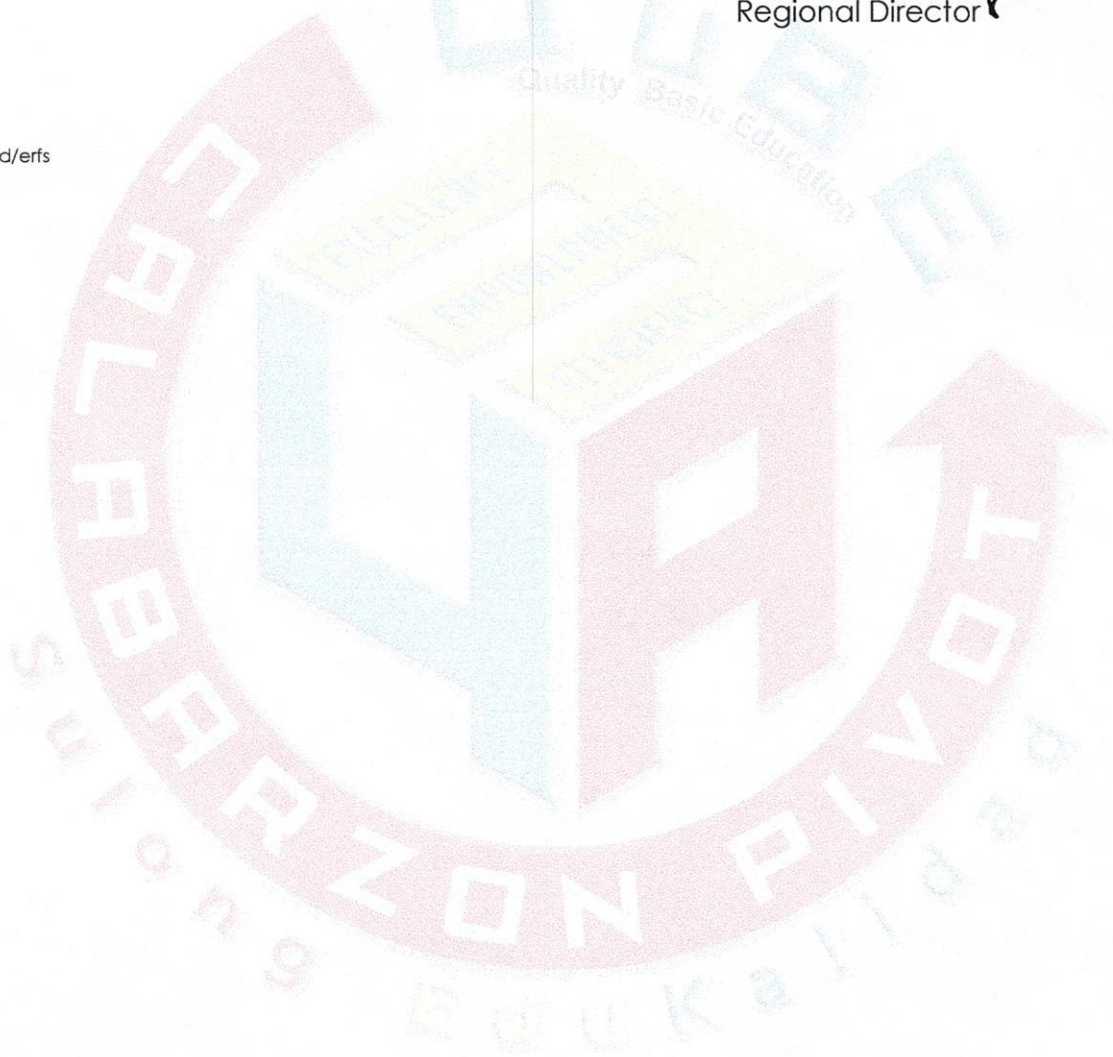
