Grade 1 - predict possible ending of story

Grade 3 - make inferences and draw conclusions based on texts

Grade 3 - interpret simple graphs, tables and pictographs

Grade 5 - infer the meaning of unfamiliar words

Said videos will be launched on a staggered timeline from January to May 2021 aligned with their expected appearance on the MELCs covered based on DepEd's Academic Year Calendar. They will be made available for free use by everyone through the following mediums:
