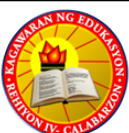
**SCHOOLS ISOLATED SUSPENSION OF CLASSES IN SOME AREAS OF THE DIVISION OF  
ANTIPOLO CITY BADLY AFFECTED BY THE TYPHOON ULYSSES**

To **Schools Division Superintendents**  
**Principal/School Heads of the Affected Schools**  
**All others concerned**

1. In view of the inaccessibility of some areas of the Division of Antipolo City because of the effects brought about by Typhoon Ulysses, such as impassable roads due to the damaged bridges, power outage, and the dangers of landslide in the area, this Office hereby suspends the distance learning activities of the schools listed hereunder from **November 16-20, 2020**:
