SUSPENSION OF DISTANCE LEARNING ACTIVITIES IN AREAS HEAVILY AFFECTED BY TYPHOON AND OTHER RELATED CONCERNS

- Tropical storm Ulysses and other recent weather disturbances put homes and schools in a difficult situation. Office personnel, teachers, parents, learners suffer the aftermath in severely affected areas particularly those which were under water for a number of days.
- 2. Relative to this, with the concurrence and approval of the Secretary, distance learning activities in five municipalities of Rizal Rodriguez, San Mateo, Cainta, Taytay, Baras-Pinugay and upland of Tanay; are hereby suspended from November 16-20, 2020. This is to provide affected personnel, families and the learners to recover from the devastating effects of the typhoon.
- 3. All schools division superintendents are instructed to conduct inventory of available self-learning modules (PIVOT4A Q1and CO) and declare buffer which can be transferred without cost to the Division of Rizal subject to existing COA rules and other policies and guidelines. The same scheme observed with the fire victims of Bacoor City shall be done.
